This map shows the accessibility offer of Festivaletteratura. You will find brief descriptions of the venues, based on different needs. Italian Sign Language (LIS) and streaming events are also listed.

Tickets: People with disabilities can send an email to perilfestival@festivaletteratura.it by **August 24th**.

The reservation entitles the person with disabilities to one paid ticket and one free ticket for a possible companion.

Assisted transport service: people with physical disabilities can request an assisted transport service using accessible vehicles. The pick-up points are the parking lots at Campo Canoa and Piazza Virgiliana. The service is free of charge and managed by trained staff.

The service is provided by Fondazione ANFFAS Mantova Onlus. Reservations must be made by September 3 by calling 0376.360515 or 338.6617278 (Graziella), Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

1. Teatro Bibiena
Via Accademia, 47



The theater entrance is accessible through a ramp. There is a double glass door. The auditorium is flat with seats reserved for wheelchair users.

7. Pescherie di Giulio Romano
Via Pescheria, 20




There is a narrow elevator inside. The cabin is 75 cm wide. The pier can be reached by a lifting platform. It is 90 cm wide.

14. Aula Magna dell'Università
Via Angelo Scarsellini, 2




Access is through a gravelled car park. The entrance to the room is through stairs with handrails. There is an alternative path with an elevator.

1.A Teatro Bibiena Sala Piermarini
Via Accademia, 47



The theater entrance is accessible through a ramp. There is a double glass door. The Piermarini Room is on the first floor. There is no elevator.

8. Basilica Palatina di Santa Barbara
Piazza Giovanni Paccagnini
Piazza Castello



Entrance dedicated to people with physical disabilities from Piazza Castello. Access is through steep ramps. The ramps and square are paved with cobblestones.

15. Chiesa di Santa Maria della Vittoria
Via Claudio Monteverdi, 1
Via Domenico Fernelli, 15




There is a secondary entrance accessible through a ramp. The door is only opened upon request. The connecting ramp is steep, with a slope exceeding 8%.

2. Biblioteca Teresiana
Via Roberto Ardigò, 13
Via Dottrina Cristiana, 10



Access to the event rooms is through 10 steps. There is no handrail. Wheelchair users can climb the steps using a mobile crawler provided here.

9. Piazza Castello
Piazza Giovanni Paccagnini
Piazza Sordello




Entrance dedicated to people with physical disabilities in Piazza Sordello. Access is via steep ramps. The ramps and square are paved with cobblestones.

16. Politecnico di Milano Campus di Mantova
Via Angelo Scarsellini, 13
Piazza Carlo D'Arco, 3




Entrance from Via Scarsellini. People with physical disabilities can reach room A.0.1 through a shorter path. From Piazza D'Arco, you can reach it directly by elevator.

3. Piazza Mantegna
Piazza Mantegna



The square is located facing the Basilica of St. Andrew. The surface is flat and paved with porphyry cubes. It is slightly uneven.

10. Piazza Lega Lombarda
Piazza Sordello



The main entrance is from the portico in Piazza Sordello. The pavement is very uneven. An alternative entrance is from Via Rubens. The pavement is in cobblestones.

17. Casa del Mantegna
Via Giovanni Acerbi, 47



The backyard of the house can be accessed through a side gate. The path is covered in gravel and grass. There is a chemical toilet for people with disabilities in the backyard.

4. Piazza Leon Battista Alberti
Piazza Leon Battista Alberti




Access is from the porticos on Via Broletto, near number 50. The portico is wide and level. Via Leon D'Oro leads to the square.

11. Tenda Sordello
Piazza Sordello




The space is located in Piazza Sordello. The square is paved with cobblestones. The widest sidewalk with regular paving is on the west side.

18. Palazzo San Sebastiano
Viale Antonio Gioppi



The events take place in the inner courtyard. The entrance is through the gate on Viale Gioppi. There is a short portion of gravel path. The courtyard is paved and flat.

5. Palazzo del Podestà
Piazza Erbe, 4
Piazza Erbe, 5




Access is through a long staircase. There is the handrail. The upper floors can be reached through two large elevators.

12. Piazza dei Libri
Piazza Sordello




The space is located in Piazza Sordello. The square is paved with cobblestones. The widest sidewalk with regular paving is on the west side.

19. Palazzo Te
Viale Te, 13



The entrance is accessible through a ramp. Events are held in Sala dei Cavalli. Other workshop activities take place in rooms on the first floor. There is no elevator.

6. Cinema Oberdan
Via Guglielmo Oberdan, 11



The room is located in the underground. There is no elevator. A platform lift with a high load capacity of 225 kg is available on request from an alternative entrance.

13. Seminario Vescovile
Via Fratelli Cairoli, 20
Via Carlo Montanari, 1



Indoor parking available for people with physical disabilities. The pavement is made of gravel. The room can be reached through an alternative path with an elevator.

20. Biblioteca Baratta
Corso Garibaldi, 88
Via Gradaro, 1



The main entrance has 3 steps. There is a handrail. It is possible to request the opening of a second side entrance, which is completely flat.

Oasi Multisensoriale
Via Giovanni Battista Spagnoli
Via Goito, Loggia del Grano

The Multisensory Oasis is located in the Loggia del Grano. Here, you can relax and unwind. This space is designed for autistic or neurodivergent people, but everyone is welcome.

If you feel overwhelmed, you can stop by the oasis to feel better. You will be welcomed by the trained staff from Casa del Sole Onlus.

Access from Via Goito is through a steep ramp. You can request the placement of an adapted mobile ramp.
